Anyone may donate. Donations through the Missoula Gives online portal to charitable nonprofit organizations are tax-deductible and cannot be refunded. Contributions may be made online via credit cards, debit cards, ACH payments, and mobile wallets. Donations will be received and receipted by GiveGab.

How Does It Work?

Visit MissoulaGives.org. Choose a charity and donate. It's simple. After registering for the giving day, all online donations collected are deposited into each nonprofits bank account within 24-48 hours. A small percent of the donations brought in may be deducted to cover administrative fees, although donors have the opportunity to cover those costs (and most do) so that the charity realizes the full donations.
